

# Guide for Inspection Procedures through Security Committee of Tourism Facilities

**The Ministry of Tourism and Antiquities shall assume inspection of the following**

- Tourism licensing
- Permits for using artist groups.
- Permits for serving alcoholic drinks.
- Quality of equipment and furnishing within the facility.
- General cleanliness of all facility areas (of the guests and clients, of the employees, of the facility).
- General cleanliness in the entire outside area of the facility.
- Compliance with the license status granted to the facility.
- Compliance with the working hours of tourist restaurants of all categories.
- Compliance of workers in the tourism facilities with their assigned uniform.
- Clear announcement of prices.
- First aid.
- Inspection equipment at facility entrances.
- Security and protection personnel.
- Non-use of Jordan's currency in night clubs.
- Disturbances to neighbors.

1. Verbal warning
2. Warning
3. Suspension from work
4. Precautionary closure
5. Closure for period decided by Tourism Committee.
6. Revoking license.

(Taking into consideration in all the above the size of magnitude of the violation).

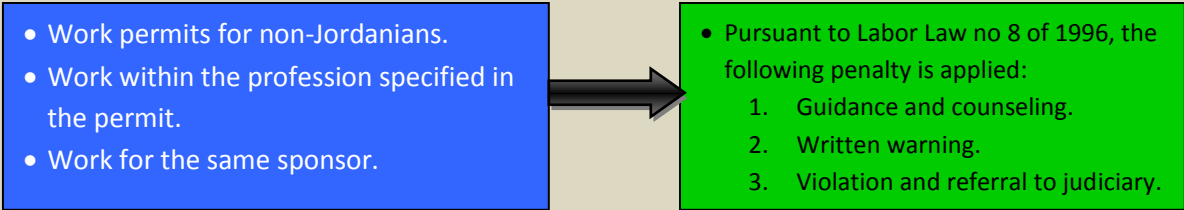
**The Ministry of Health shall assume inspection of the following**

- Staff health certificates.
- Food items storage.
- Food items validity.
- Food items warehouses.
- Cleanliness of food items preparation area.
- Packaging and storage.

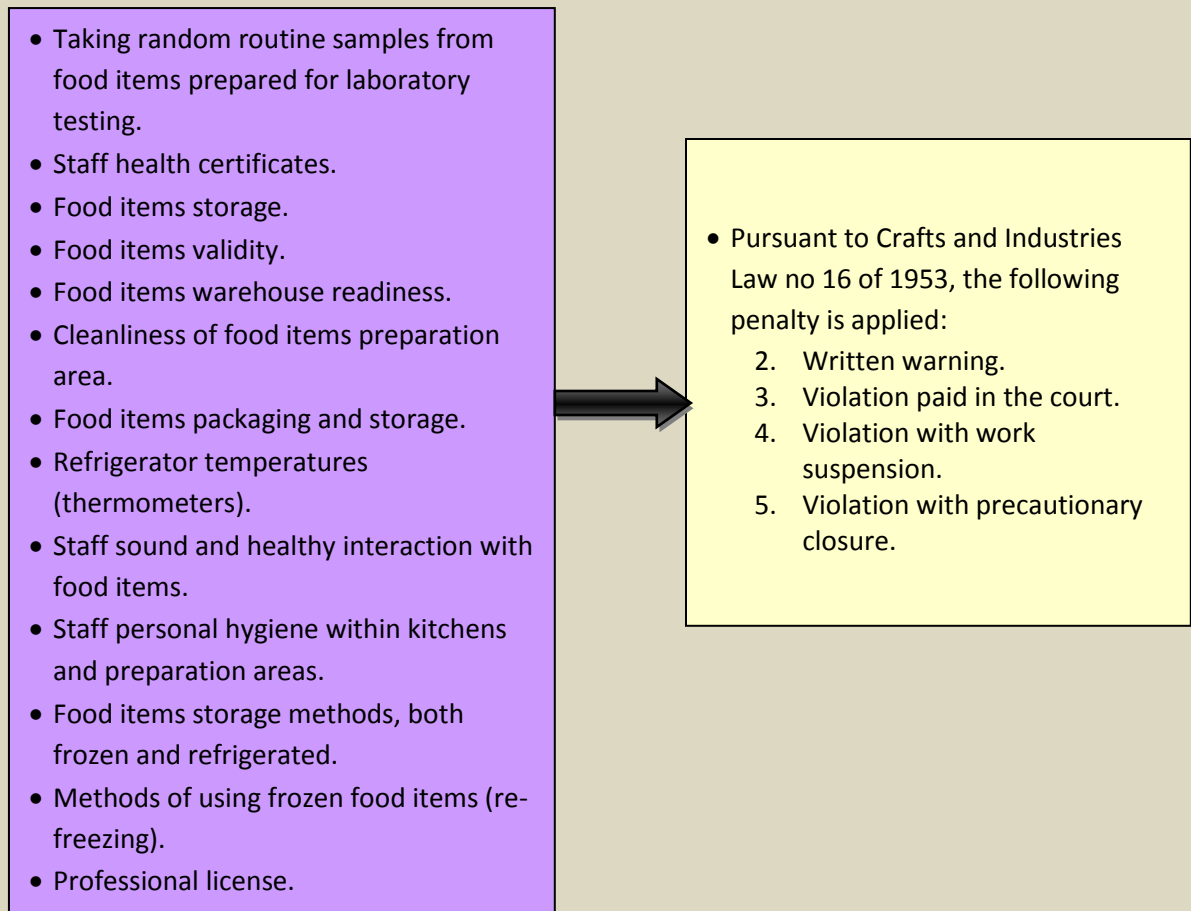
Pursuant to the Food Monitoring Law no 79 of 2001, the following penalty is applied:

1. Paid violation
2. Referral to Magistrate Court
3. Precautionary shut down
4. Fine
5. Stakeholder's imprisonment
6. Or both penalties in 4 and 5.
